

In order to avoid sales tax on purchases for resale, please download the Sales Tax Exemption Certificate(s) below. Fill out the certificate(s), then return via fax to: 336-519-0253 or email to: b2b.service@hanes.com.

If you are receiving goods in or, on your behalf, having goods shipped to [Massachusetts](#), [Minnesota](#), [New York](#), or [Virginia](#), please complete, sign and date the state specific form, as these are the only acceptable forms for those states.

If you are receiving goods in or, on your behalf, having goods shipped to **Indiana**, **West Virginia**, or **Wyoming**, please complete, sign and date the [Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement Certificate of Exemption](#) including registration number(s) and, for **Indiana**, provide a copy of your Registered Retail Merchant Certificate.

If you are receiving goods in or, on your behalf, having goods shipped to **Louisiana** or **Florida**, please provide a signed and dated copy of the state supplied Reseller Certificate for the current year.

If you are receiving goods in or, on your behalf, having goods shipped to **Mississippi**, please provide a copy of your sales tax permit.

If you are receiving goods in or, on your behalf, having goods shipped to [Oregon](#), please complete, sign and date the state specific form.

If you are receiving goods in or, on your behalf, having goods shipped to any other state, complete the [Uniform Sales & Use Tax Certificate – Multijurisdictional](#) form including sales tax registration numbers for all states where you are registered to collect and remit sales tax (generally where you have a physical presence). The form must be signed and dated.

Special instructions for drop-shippers:

Shipments on your behalf to customers in the following states will be subject to sales tax unless one of the above forms is received with your sales tax registration number for CA, CT, DC, FL, HI, MD, MS, TN.

Shipments on your behalf to customers in the state of **Louisiana** will be subject to sales tax unless you provide either your signed and dated LA Reseller Certificate or a signed and dated letter on company letterhead stating that you do not have a physical presence in nor are registered as a retailer in Louisiana.

Special instructions for overseas shipments:

In general, if a sale is made to a company for export outside of the United States, it is not subject to sales tax. However, in order for this exemption to apply, delivery must not be made to the purchaser within the United States. The seller must deliver the property either directly outside the US or to a qualified export agent. Please complete the [Uniform Sales & Use Tax Certificate – Multijurisdictional](#) form and provide the name and address of the freight forwarder/export agent. Note: All brands and/or categories may not be sold in all countries or territories. Please contact [customer service](#) with your intent of country and brand or category.

Please note: You must complete the Certificate(s) to become a Hanesbrands B2B partner, so please send it to us soon. In order to speed up the verification process, please provide a copy of your sales tax permit with each completed STEC form.

- Did you provide the resale number / license number / Registration number etc. as applicable per state /form?
